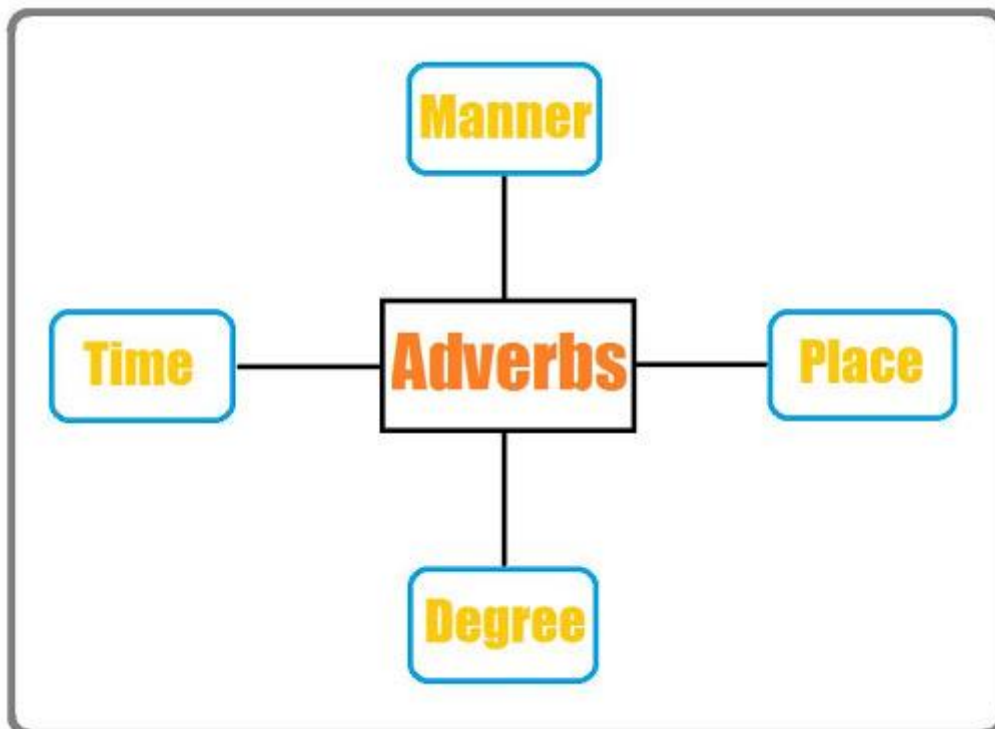
✚ First, what is adverb??

Example

1. **Later** Ana ate some salad. *This time is more important*
2. Ana **later** ate some salad. *This time is more formal. Policeman's report*
3. Ana ate some salad **later**. *This is neutral, no particular emphasis*
