Cyberbullying is ____9____ that takes place over digital devices like cell phones, computers, and tablets. Cyberbullying can ____10____ through SMS, text, and apps, or online in social media, forums, or gaming where people can view, participate in, or share content. ____11____ cyberbullying includes sending, posting, or sharing negative, harmful, false, or mean content about someone else. It can include ____12____ of personal or private information about someone else causing embarrassment or humiliation. Some cyberbullying crosses the line into unlawful or criminal behaviour.

The 2017 Youth Risk Behaviour Surveillance System indicates that an estimated 14.9% of high school students were electronically bullied in the 12 months prior to the survey.
